The general policy of Down Syndrome Victoria is to support research that has the possibility to enhance the lives of people with Down syndrome. As such, Down Syndrome Victoria is prepared to act as an agent to offer access to members but will not endorse specific projects. We require Committee approval of the projects that meet the criteria:

Each application must:

- Come via a university / research institute with an Australian Human Ethics Committee
- Have ethics approval from that institution
- Involve no cost to Down Syndrome Victoria (*each request will priced on application*)
- Provide an executive summary of results to Down Syndrome Victoria
- Must complete the following application form
- Receive approval by the Down Syndrome Victoria Committee (who meet monthly)
